

OREGON TRANSFER MODULE (OTM)

The **Oregon Transfer Module (OTM)** is a set of **45 general education credits** recognized by all Oregon community colleges and public universities. It is designed for students who plan to transfer and want to complete a core block of education requirements.

The OTM is **not a degree or certificate**, but is recorded on a student's transcript upon completion. While it can help streamline the transfer process, students should work with an advisor to ensure courses align with the intended major and transfer institution.
